Rules of Conduct

- The SDSDC does not tolerate any form of sexual harassment (verbal or physical).
- Teaching on the social dance floor is not appropriate. Even so called “friendly advice” regarding another’s dancing can be hurtful.
- Standing and talking on the dance floor takes away valuable dance space. Please socialize off the floor.
- Be considerate of other dancers. Remember, West Coast Swing is considered a slotted dance and that we all need to share the floor.
- It is important to try and stay in your own dance space and take smaller steps when necessary, especially when the floor is full.
- Dancing brings us into others’ personal space; we all need to be aware of our personal hygiene.
- To avoid hurt feelings, if you refuse a dance for any reason, avoid accepting another invitation during the same song.
- Flirtation is a part of dancing, but sexually suggestive dancing is bad form.
- Dress appropriately with a reasonable level of decorum.
- Please bus your table and do not create additional work for our wonderful volunteers.
