Taylor quickly became involved with SDSDC, serving two years as the Events and Activities Director and now as the club's Newsletter Editor while splitting her time between Colorado, California, and beyond. She's currently embracing a year of



adventure, connection, and growth through her latest venture, Traveling Dancers – a passion project she's building with her mom (whom many of you have met!), Amy Thomas. Their mission is to elevate dance experiences by pairing people with places to dance. Through community-driven insight, tailored solutions, and curated resources, they aim to help dancers navigate the shared journey that connects us all.
